



Grandview Vision and Hearing Screenings



Vision and hearing screening is conducted at check-in for students at Grandview, which is required according to Colorado law. All students in 9th grade receive vision and hearing screening, as well as any 10th, 11th, or 12th graders who are new to the school district.

Because of the important connection between a student's academic achievement and his/her vision and hearing, parents are encouraged to allow their child to participate in this screening. If your student does not complete the screening during check-in, they may be called out of class and screened at a later date.

Please have your student wear their glasses or contacts to check-in.

Vision: The screening is done by the school at no charge to the parent. Ninth-graders receive distance screening. Remember, the vision screening is just a screening, not a complete ophthalmologic exam that is provided by a doctor. **You will be notified only if your student does not pass the screening.**

Hearing: The screening is done by district licensed audiologists at no charge to the parent.

Additional diagnostic audiological evaluations are available free of charge at the district's Audiology Department for:

Students whose hearing screening results indicate a potential problem and are given a hearing referral
Annual follow-up for students who have a history of hearing problems
